- to have provided each contractor and its personnel who, for any reason, will be involved during the event or in set-up and/or dismantling activities, with a copy of the **Exhibition Technical Regulations** and **Exhibition Centre risk assessment document ("DUVRI")**, as well as detailed information on the specific risks and prevention and emergency measures in force in the environment in which they are to operate.

3) Regarding the drafting of the operational safety plan:

regarding the drafting of the appropriate documentation for the purposes of Consolidated Act 81 of 2008 as amended. :

that in the course of setting up and/or dismantling their stand it will draw up:

- the Operational Safety Plan ("POS") with the minimum contents of Annex VI of Italian Interministerial Decree of 22 July 2014, if it carries out the fitting out works directly through INTERNAL COMPANY PERSONNEL;

- if one or more contractors are used to carry out the stand construction work, the contractor(s) must draw up the Operational Safety Plan ("POS"); the Exhibitor, on the other hand, as the client, must draw up the stand's internal interference risk assessment document (stand "DUVRI") if several contractors are working on the stand at the same time or if the contractor(s) interfere with the company's own personnel (e.g. in charge of positioning machines, etc.).

- If the set-up and dismantling activities or any other work in the exhibition complex falls within the scope of Title IV of Italian Decree 81/08 (Worksites), the Exhibitor must name the figure of the "Safety Co-ordinator in the Design Phase", who will prepare the Coordination and Safety Plan ("PSC") of the stand whose contents are defined in Annex VI of Italian Interministerial Decree 22 July 2014.
